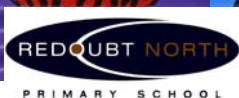

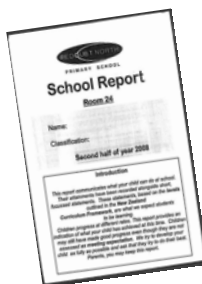
## WELCOME
