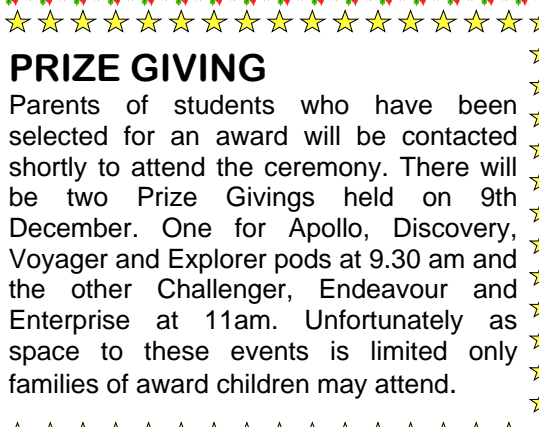


CHRISTMAS ASSEMBLIES

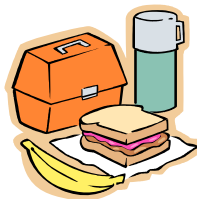
