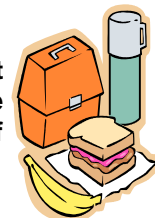
SWIMMING LESSONS IN TERM 1

THE TWITS

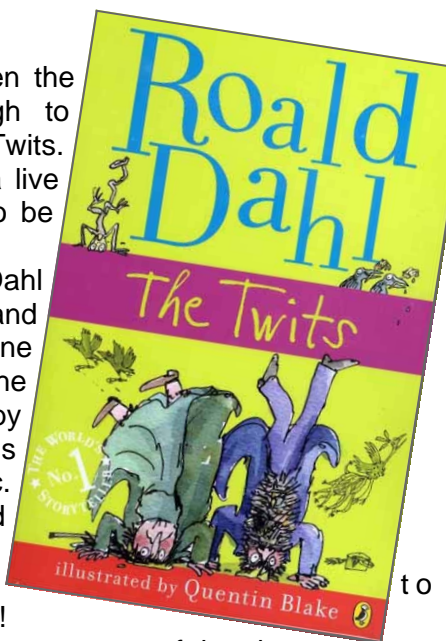
