VISIT BY ST JOHN AMBULANCE OFFICERS

Have you ever wondered what to do in an emergency?

Rooms 14, 15 and 16 are the ones to call on for help now after an excellent session with St John Ambulance staff.

The students learned how to assess an unconscious person. First check for the safety of yourself and the patient, then check for a response. Is their airway open? Are they breathing? If no signs of life, start CPR. Lastly check for severe bleeding.

The children practised ringing 111 and putting the patient in the Recovery position. It was a great learning experience for everyone involved.
