### **BOTANNICAL GARDENS**

During last term our Enviro Group students were learning about stormwater in Auckland and water pollution. Stormwater is rain which falls on our roads and roofs, and goes down our roadside

drains before it is discharged into our streams and the sea. The students have learnt that this water is often polluted and contains litter, soil, sediments, oils and other contaminants which are harmful to freshwater and sea animals.

As a follow-on from our water pollution lessons, we visited the Auckland Botanic Gardens to see some stormwater treatment solutions (such as green roofs) in action! The students followed the Sustainable Water Trail walk around the Gardens. Our young Enviro Scientists are now part of the development of our own green roof at school.



### **HIP HOP CLASS**

In week 1 we welcomed back our Year 7 and 8 students with a journey into the culture of Hip Hop! We spent the day learning and exploring aspects of dance from three amazing members of our community.
