ROYAL NZ AIR FORCE SCHOOL TO SKIES PROGRAMME

What a fantastic day we had this week with the Royal New Zealand Air Force "On The Road" team, who came to our school to deliver an Aviation STEM Programme to our Year 7 and 8 students. During the day, students learnt basic tool control, principles of flight knowledge and participated in a series of maintenance jobs on the plane. These included looking at the engine in the Grumman, discussing the piston engine theory and how a 4 stroke engine cycle occurs in the Grumman. The students also had the opportunity to sit in the cockpit where they learnt about the axes of control and the moveable surfaces of the aircraft. They discussed the uniforms, tried them on and learnt about the features on the outside frame of the aircraft.
