GINGERBREAD MAN BAKING ENDEAVOUR ONE

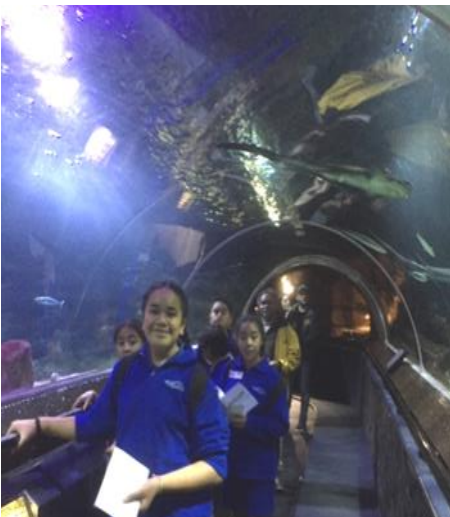
Endeavour One has been enjoying learning about the Gingerbread Man.

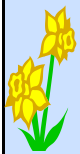
