## WE ARE CELEBRATING!! EDUCATION REVIEW REPORT DECEMBER 2017

We are now able to advise you of the findings in our latest Education Review Report which was completed last term.

The Education Review team visited our school in Term 4 2017 to look at how our school was performing under a series of headings. This covered: Equity, Excellence, Legal Requirements, Strengths and Next Steps for the school.

We are delighted to advise you that for the second consecutive time we have received a 4-5 year Review. This is a major achievement for our school and we are very proud of the Report findings indicating we are a High Performing School. Excerpts from the report are as follows:

- The school is very effective in achieving equitable and excellent outcomes for its students.
- The school consistently succeeds in promoting high levels of student achievement.
- Students achieve very well in relation to other outcomes valued by the school. Students:
  - are proud to attend the school
  - consistently demonstrate the school values
  - attend school regularly and are very well engaged in their learning.
  - participate in a wide range of learning opportunities and experiences.
- The school responds very effectively to Māori and other students whose learning and achievement need acceleration.
- School leaders expect all children to be successful during their time at the school. Their commitment to all children achieving is shared by teachers.
- Teachers and leaders are highly strategic and responsive to the learning needs of all children. They work closely with children, differentiating programmes in response to children's strength and learning needs.
- A positive school climate and effective routines promote an environment where children can be successful learners. Children and staff respond well to the high expectations that are set.
- Trustees share a strong commitment to fully supporting the school's pursuit of excellence.
- Children learn in very settled and purposeful classroom environments where their work is valued and they are encouraged to take pride in their achievement. Respectful relationships between teachers and children are the basis for the positive tone in classrooms.
- Key strengths of the school:
  - leadership that promotes consistently good practice and high expectations
  - responding to individual children's learning needs that results in high achievement
  - establishing and maintaining the positive learning culture and environments that support children well to engage in their learning.

## START OF YEAR REMINDERS:

### SCHOOL HOURS
